Code of Conduct

The purpose of the TIME Code of Conduct is to ensure a happy and safe mission experience for all involved. All participants shall agree to adhere to the precepts laid out within...

Participation

Youth participants shall willingly participate fully in the programs and elements of the TIME Roofing Mission. These include, participation in the roofing experience, staying in gender-specific TIME provided overnight lodging, and using TIME secured gender-specific showering facilities, taking meals with TIME, taking part in TIME assigned Team chores, participating in TIME organized recreational activities and participating in TIME devotional and chapel programming based on Christian values.

Dress Code

All TIME participants dress shall reflect good taste and concern for the values and standards of other participants. Inappropriate dress includes but is not limited to the following: extremely short shorts, clothing promoting alcohol, drugs, tobacco or distasteful language, provocative swimwear, clothing that exposes bare midriffs, cleavage or bust lines, clothing with spaghetti straps, and sheer, distressed or sagging clothing which exposes undergarments. Participants may be asked to change if TIME Administrators deems clothing inappropriate. Note: On the project sites, all TIME participants shall wear clothing appropriate for roofing. Long pants and closed toed shoes are required for roofing.

Mutual Respect

All TIME participants shall respect one another to include everyone's feelings, physical person, and personal property. Youth shall respect adults and likewise adults shall respect youth.

Homeowner Respect

All TIME participants shall be respectful of our homeowners and their personal property.

Timekeeper Respect

Youth and adult team members shall respect the authority of the project site's Timekeepers. In addition, Timekeepers shall respect the abilities of their team members.

Project Site Respect

Roofing is hard work and at times tedious. It is important to appreciate the unique abilities everyone brings to the project site. There are no big jobs and no little jobs, just jobs.....all participants should strive to find a job that makes their team most successful and then everyone can share in the glory of a roof well done.

Facilities Respect

All TIME participants shall be good stewards of the facilities, equipment, and vehicles used by TIME. Vandalism will not be tolerated. Payment to repair damage due to vandalism shall be the responsibility of the offending participant's parent(s) or guardian(s).

Transportation

All youth participants shall ride seat belted in TIME approved transportation. No youth may drive a personal vehicle unless expressly authorized to do so by TIME Administration. No youth may ride in another youth's personal vehicle. With the exception of the shower shuttles, all youth shall return to venues in the vehicle in which they departed.

Electronic Devices

Electronic devices, to include but not limited to cell phones and iPods, shall not be used by youth participants on the project sites or during worship. Timekeepers may have their cell phone accessible on their project site for the express purpose of communicating with TIME Administration or TIME Construction Specialist. Devices inappropriately used will be confiscated. Note: TIME is not responsible for loss of or damage to electronic devices brought to the Mission.

Groups of "3" Rule

All participants shall make every effort to always hang out and travel in groups of at least (3) three persons. This insures a level of inclusivity, accountability, and safety.

PDA

Overt public display of affection between young men and young ladies participating in TIME is not permitted.

Excused Absence from Participation

Youth participants shall remain with the group for the duration of TIME. Absences shall be excused for the following reasons only: academic and athletic commitments that cannot be rescheduled.

Note: Routine Medical and dental check-ups should not be scheduled during TIME.
